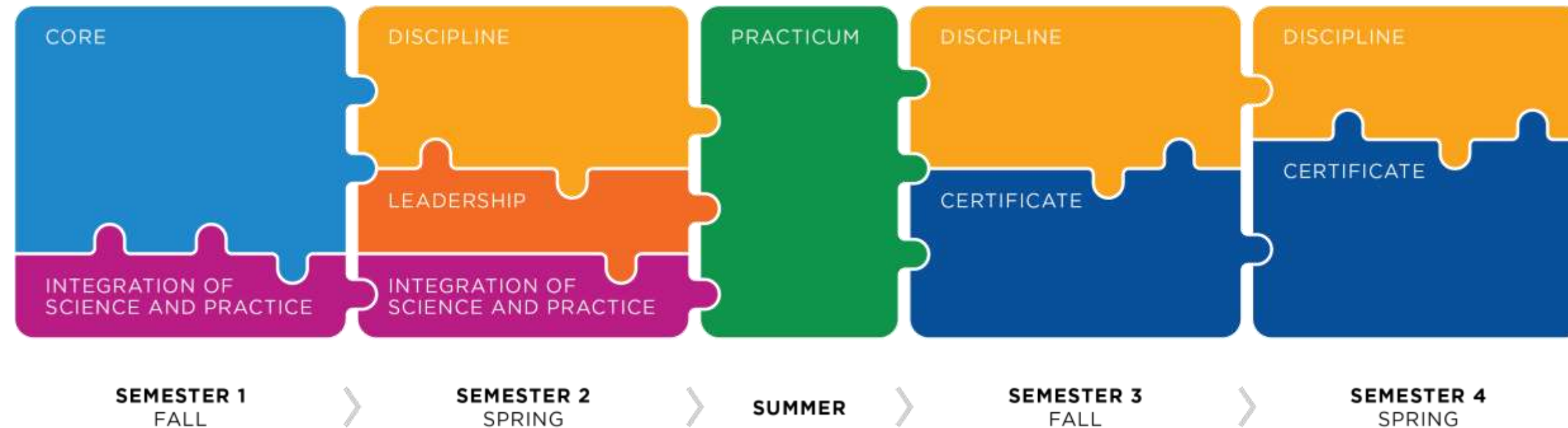

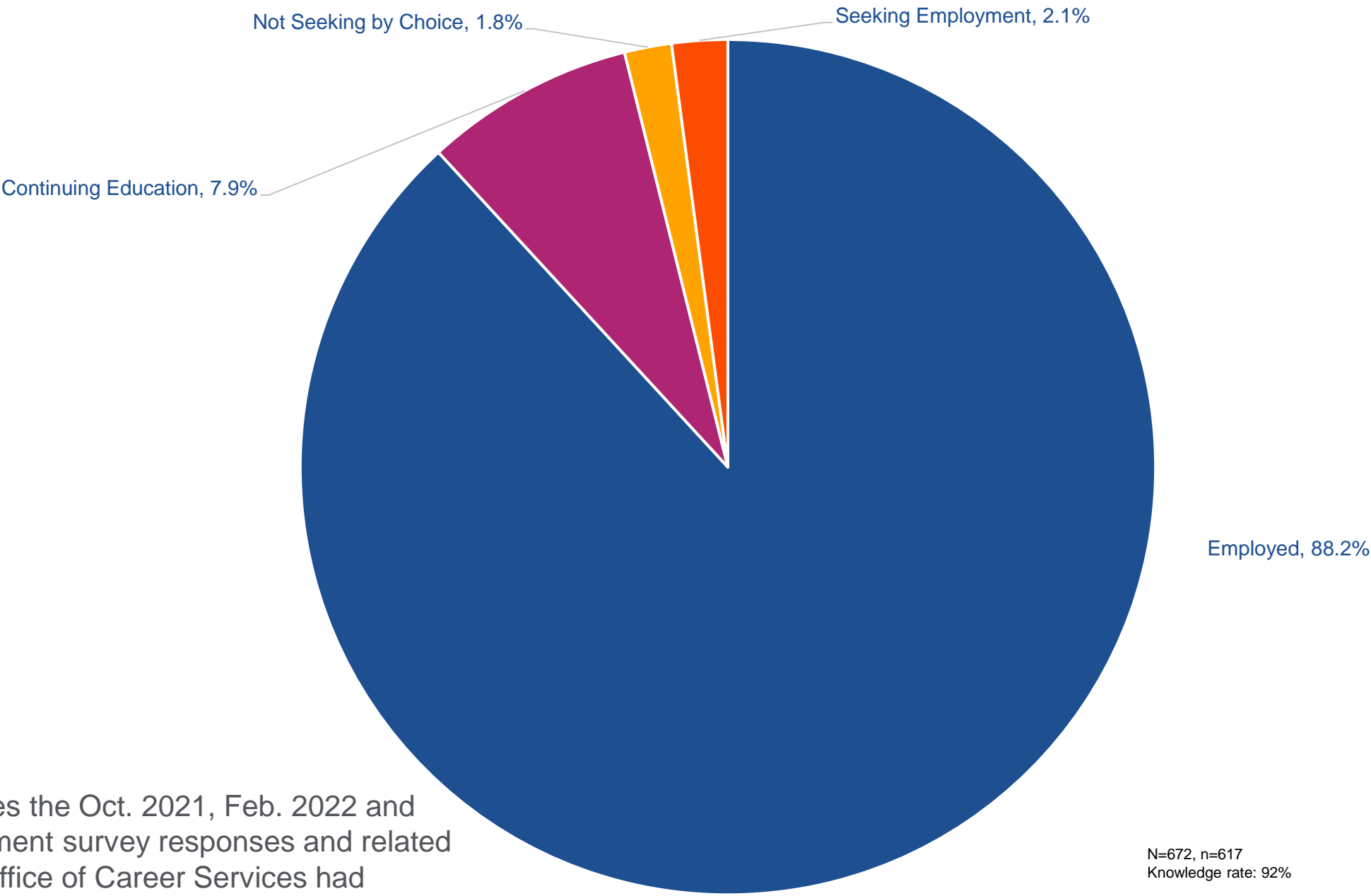


CAREER SERVICES RESOURCES

POST GRADUATE OUTCOMES



This report analyzes the Oct. 2021, Feb. 2022 and May 2022 employment survey responses and related information. The Office of Career Services had information regarding 617 graduates as of Jan. 31, 2023, from a total of 672 graduates surveyed, a knowledge rate of 92%.

OUTSIDE FUNDING

- **Network**—solicit friends/family to help in the search.
- **Sources** – related to public health and varied search terminology

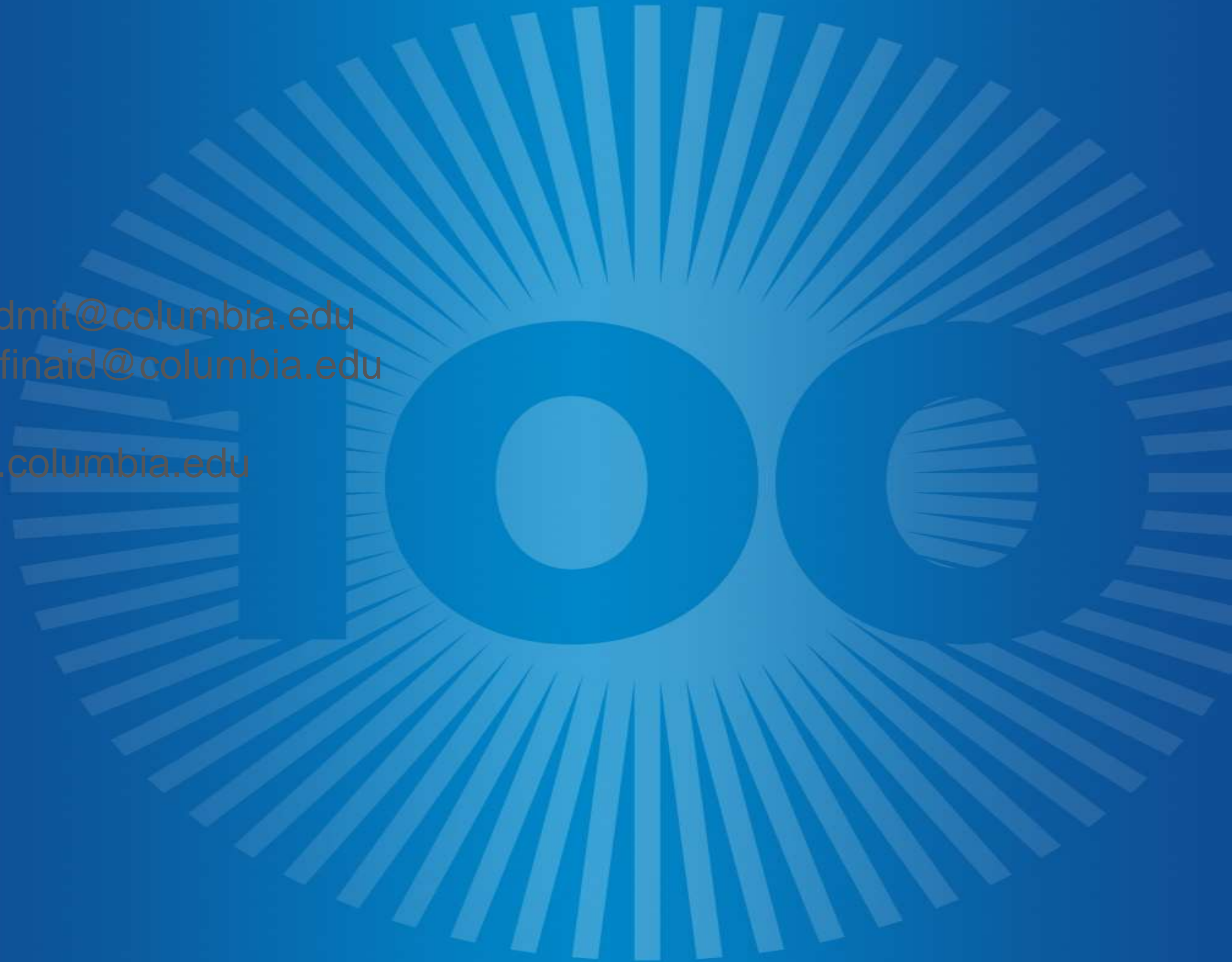
- ✓ Resume/CV
 - Volunteering, research, extracurriculars, etc.
- ✓ Statement of Purpose
 - 500 words answering, “why Columbia Mailman?”, indicating your degree/departamental interest and public health goals
- ✓ Letters of Recommendation (3)
 - Sent from a professional email address by an advisor, professor, mentor or supervisor
- ✓ Transcripts
 - Sent through SOPHAS; additional WES evaluation required for international applicants
- ✓ Completed SOPHAS Application
- ✓ Test Optionality
 - Evidence of quantitative and analytical writing required in lieu of test scores

MPH + MHSA Application Requirements

- ALL documents submitted via **SOPHAS**
- Standardized test scores are NOT required
 - Michigan Public Health does not require nor review the GRE or any other standardized test scores for admission to any masters or doctoral programs
- Michigan Public Health practices a ***holistic review*** when making graduate student admission decisions. Reviewers give careful consideration to all materials submitted by a student.

Deadlines

Admissions are for **Fall term only.**

- All graduate applications are **open.**
- **Priority deadline for all residential programs is 12/1/2025.**
- **Priority deadline for Online is February 15, 2026.**
- **Final deadline for international residential program applicants is 1/15/2026.**
- **Final deadline for online MPH and domestic residential MPH is 5/15/2026.**
- ***Admissions reviews are on a rolling basis after the priority deadline.***

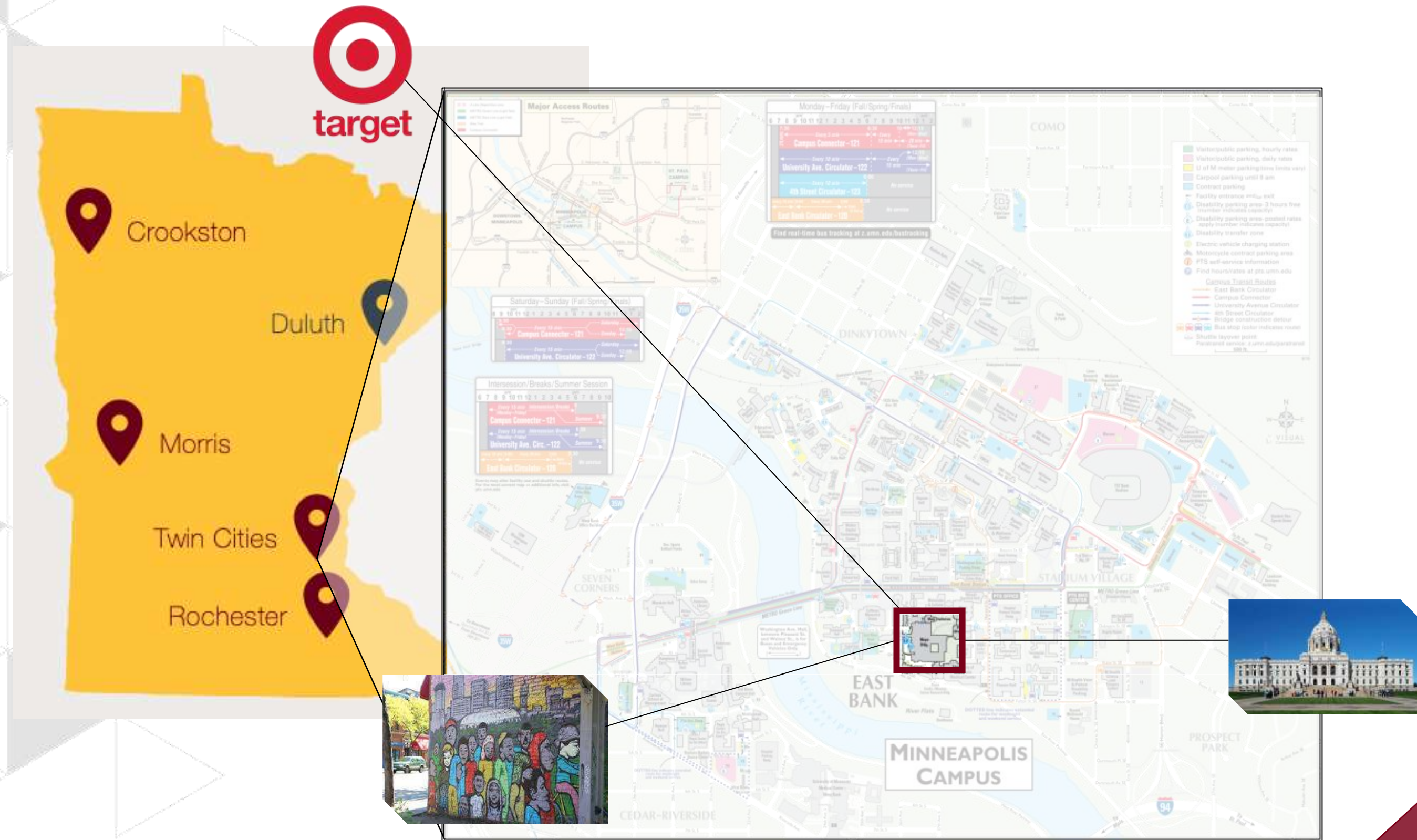
