




# 5-Year Average Trends APPLICATIONS






In recognition of the significant, increasing demand for public health professionals in the US caused by an aging population and a growing emphasis on health promotion and preventative care, as well as the potential challenges from the termination of the Grad PLUS loan in July 2026, **University of Puget Sound is aiming to make its high quality, transdisciplinary Master of Public Health program more accessible and affordable to a greater number of prospective students by introducing an expanded academic scholarship** 

#### **How to Qualify**

As part of the admission review process, new students applying to start in the MPH program for the fall semester of 2026 will be automatically evaluated for an academic scholarship disbursed across two years of study. Students admitted to the program will also receive information of their merit scholarship offer and its terms at the time of acceptance.

For **full-time students**, tuition is charged at a flat rate. Full-time students pay the same amount whether they take 8 credit hours or 18 credit hours.

Part-time students are charged tuition at a per-credit-hour rate of \$1,839.

### Who can apply?
