12-Month MPH Timeline

Eligible programs:

BSPH ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS



Deadlines: Varies upon degree and department

Application:

•<u>SOPHAS</u>: Doctoral, Master's, and Residency programs. (MHA applicants can choose to apply through SOPHAS or HAMPCAS)

•<u>SOPHAS Express</u>: Certificate programs, Bachelor's/Master's combined degree (JHU undergraduates only), and Special Student Regular applicants.

•HAMPCAS: MHA applicants apply through HAMPCAS or through SOPHAS.

•<u>DICAS</u>: MSPH in Human Nutrition – Dietitian applicants must apply through DICAS.

In general, all degree program applicants must submit the following:

- All Transcripts
- Three Letters of Recommendation
- Resume or CV
- Statement of Purpose
- Test Scores

Test Scores: GRE, GMAT, MCAT [varies upon Degree and Department]
TOEFL or IELTS for International Students

Work Experience: Preferred and required by some programs

Application Deadlines

December 1st - Decisions provided by early February.

February 1st - Decisions provided by the end of March.

March 15th - Final application deadline and decisions provided by end of April.

- Applicants considered equally across the deadlines; applying earlier means a decision sooner
- All materials, including transcripts and letters of recommendation, must be in SOPHAS by the final deadline (8:59pm Pacific Standard Time)
- SOPHAS verification process: Can take up to 4 weeks, so plan sufficient time for delivery of materials
