

Advisory Committees: Call for Nominations

ASPPH Advisory Committees advise the Board of Directors on organizational policies, and provide oversight and leadership on critical issues related to ASPPH activities. Nominations are open for all nine Advisory Committees: Accreditation, Advocacy, Data, Education, Global Engagement and Partnerships, Institutional Excellence, Practice, Research, and Technology. Advisory Committees are limited to 20 people each. Primary representatives, faculty, and staff from ASPPH members are eligible to nominate themselves. Nominees may only express interest and submit a nomination for one Advisory Committee.

Term of Office

Appointed members carry a two-year term, with the option of reappointment for up to three terms (six years total).

Time Commitment

Advisory Committees meet once a year in person at the ASPPH Annual Meeting and at least two other times per year virtually. The time commitment can vary across committees depending on goals and projects.

Qualifications

Self-nominations will be accepted from primary representatives, faculty, and staff of ASPPH member institutions in good standing with a permanent or full-time appointment at an ASPPH member school or program of public health. ASPPH is seeking nominees that represent the great diversity of our members. Nominees should have expertise/active engagement in the Advisory Committee area.

Timeline

- Self-nomination period:
November 19 – December 12, 2025
- Notifications to nominees:
January 26 – 30, 2026
